### Start/Finish:

Will be on private land situated in Bridgend postcode: **CF32 0BT**. The open hare and Hound Format event will start at 11:00am for a sighting lap. First riders will be set off at 12 noon and end at around 14:30pm. Adult event is a 2.5 hour event and the start is a dead engine start.

### Course Markings:

Orange day glo arrows, green day glo arrows, orange day glo paint, white tape and blue tape are used to mark the course:

- Single orange arrows – Stay with 15ft either side of arrow
- Gated orange arrows (2 arrows) – Riders must pass between the two arrows.
- Single green arrows – Easy Route stay with 15ft either side of arrow
- Gated green arrows (2 arrows) – Easy Route riders must pass between the two arrows.
- Crossed orange or green arrows – Danger/Caution slow down
- Orange paint – Shows direction or highlights hazard
- White tape – always stay within the tapes
- Blue Tape – Pits and Scoring areas walking pace only.

### Course:

The course has been measured at just under 6 miles, with an expert rider completing the lap in 14 minutes and all refuelling will be at the start/finish area. The course will consist of Coal Tips, Rocks, Banks, Stream Crossings, Jumps and Tricky Climbs. There will be easy and hard routes on parts of the course with orange dayglo arrows marking the normal route and green arrows marking easier routes. Crossed arrows will mean caution.

### Numbers and Backgrounds:

Numbers and backgrounds are not supplied. Numbers allocated as within final entry list. Colours of numbers and backgrounds are as follows:

- Expert – Green Background White Numbers
- Clubman and O40 – Yellow Backgrounds Black Numbers
- Sportsman, O50 and Pre 90 – Black Background with White Numbers or White Backgrounds with Black Numbers

### Machine Examination/Sign On:

Signing on will be 09:00 – 10:30 and machine examination will be from 09:00 -10:30.

### Noise:

Any machine not showing this will not be examined. Random noise tests may take place during the event. Failure to stop for a noise test will result in immediate exclusion.

### Tyres:

No Restrictions

### Notes:

- **Due to a supplier letting us down last minute we regret there will be no toilet facilities on site.**
- **There is no burger van, food or drink facilities so please bring enough water for hydration the weather has been extremely hot so keep hydrated.**
- Only riders that have signed on can ride or be on the course. Action will be taken against unauthorised persons found riding or driving in the land or on any part of the course.
- Ensure that you do not block the free run of the competitor into and through refuelling points.
- No smoking is allowed within 20 metres of the refuelling areas or the start finish area.
