Start/Finish:

Will be on private land situated in postcode: **SA13 2SS**. The open Sprint Enduro Format event will start at 9:00am on Sunday 22nd May.

- 9:00am to 11:30am Sportsman, Over 40, Youth 13-16 and Ladies
- 12:30pm to 15:00pm Clubman, Expert and Championship

Format:

Riders will be set off in waves. Each event is 2.5hrs in duration and will follow the ACU Hare and Hound format.

Course Markings:

Orange Arrows and Paint

White tape and blue tape are used to mark the course. Tied dangling tape may be used in addition to arrows to mark the route and a single arrow rule will apply to this marking method.

- Single Arrows/White tied tape Must stay within 15ft/3 bike widths either side of the arrow.
- Gated Arrows (2 arrows parallel) Riders must pass between the two arrows.
- Crossed Arrows Danger/Caution slow down
- Coloured Paint Shows direction and/or highlights hazards
- White Tape Routes always stay within the tapes
- Blue Tape Routes Pits and Scoring areas walking pace only stay within the tapes.
- There will be signs on part of the track to direct you to either easy or hard routes. Hard routes will gain a time advantage.

Course:

The course has been measured at around 3 miles, with an expert rider completing the lap in around 7 minutes and all refuelling will be near the parking area in the blue taped off area. The course will consist of Hills, Grass Fields, Marsh Fields, Rocks, Banks, Streams, and Jumps.

Numbers, Backgrounds and Timing:

Numbers and backgrounds are supplied during signing on:

- Transponders are to be mounted on the front mudguard facing upwards, number/backgrounds are to be mounted on
 the front number/headlight board of the motorcycle. You are solely responsible for the mounting of the transponder
 and number/background. Do not cut the number background. You are only given one number/background and
 transponder (others are available at a cost of £5).
- Transponder timing will pick up your lap time during your pass through the timing section of the course. This area is **walking pace only**.

Signing On:

- Signing on will be from 07:30 08:30am Sunday. There will be a short duration to sign on at 11:45 to 12:15 for PM riders.
- Signing on either day will only be for events on that day.

Noise:

Random noise tests may take place during the event. Failure to stop for a noise test will result in immediate exclusion.

Tyres:

No Restrictions

Notes:

- **SPECTATORS** Are allowed however there will be no parking provided so will have to enter by foot. Please do not park in Cwm Farteg or surrounding streets this is critical to the future of this event.
- All Riders must enter before 9:00am or 11:30 12:30 as the gates will be shut after 9:00am and 12:30pm.
- Only riders that have signed on can ride or be on the course. Action will be taken against unauthorised persons
 found riding or driving in the land or on any part of the course.
- Ensure that you do not block the free run of the competitor into and through refuelling points.
- No smoking is allowed within 20 metres of the refuelling areas, or the start finish area.
- Please follow Welsh Government Covid 19 Guidelines/Regulations.

ANY COURSE CUTTING OR BREAKING OF THE RULES LAID OUT WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION.
