Start/Finish:

Will be on private land situated in Bridgend postcode: **CF32 0BT**. The Open Hare and Hound Format main event will take place over the two days. The Saturday will consist of an easier track with the ability of youth riders and big bikes (on track at separate times) to be able to navigate the terrain. The morning will consist of two 1 hour youth events with the first being for 8-12 year olds a shorter track situated near the paddock, with the second event being the 13-16 year old riders riding the longer course that the big bikes will be riding later. The afternoon will see one 2 hour long event for the big bikes over 600cc singles and multi cylinder bikes as part of the South Wales Trail Bike Championship.

During the Sunday there will be two events one in the morning and one in the afternoon. The morning event will be for the Sportsman, Ladies and over 40 riders and will consist of the same track as the afternoon race with a few hills/obstacles removed. The afternoon event will be for Championship, Expert and Clubman riders and will be the full course. The morning event will be 2 hours in duration whereas the afternoon will be 3 hours in duration, and both will be part of the South Wales Extreme Championship.

Entries and Fees:

Will not be returned unless the event is cancelled or a rider gives a valid reason for not riding, in writing at least 7 days prior to the event. In such cases £10 will be deducted to cover costs. Entries remain open until the 5th January 2022 or when full. If the entry is full then a reserve list will be set up.

Eligibility:

All riders must hold a current ACU or SACU competition licence, and be aged 16 or over. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident insurance.

ACU Membership and ACU Competition Licence:

You will need an annual Enduro Competition Licence, or a one event competition licence, which includes ACU Membership.

Championship – Sunday 12:30pm

Expert – Sunday 12:30pm

Clubman – Sunday 12:30pm

Over 40 – Sunday 09:30am

Ladies – Sunday 09:30am

Sportsman – Sunday 09:30am

Multi Cylinder Bikes – Saturday 13:00pm

Over 600cc Singles – Saturday 13:00pm

Youth 8 to 12 – Saturday 10:00pm

Course:

It is expected that the lap length will be approximately 5 miles with all refuelling at the start/finish area. The course will consist of Coal Tips, Rocks, Banks, Stream Crossings, Gulleys, Jumps and Tricky Climbs. There will be separate courses for separate events based on the classes.

Orange arrows – Sunday Event (Tape will be used to divert morning event around hard obstacles)

Green Arrows – Saturday PM Event

Blue Arrows – Saturday AM Event

Crossed arrows will mean extreme caution to be taken. Blue taped areas and pit area is walking pace only. You must travel between gated arrows. Where a single marker is present you must not travel further than 6 metres either side of the marker.

Course cutting will result in disqualification.

Rules/Penalties:

As laid down in the 2022 ACU Handbook.

Machine Examination/Sign On:

Signing on and scrutineering will be 08:00 – 09:00am both days. Please leave sufficient time for both. You may only sign on and scrutineer for an event on the same day.

Noise:

Random noise tests may take place during the event. Failure to stop for a noise test will result in immediate exclusion. Excessively loud motorcycles or motorcycles fitted with aftermarket pipes without DB inserts will be stopped from riding. This venue fragile to noise complaints please help us keep running events in the area.

Tyres:

No Restrictions

Notes:

- Only riders that have signed on can ride or be on the course. Action will be taken against unauthorised persons found riding or driving in the land or on any part of the course.
- Ensure that you do not block the free run of the competitor into and through refuelling points.
- No smoking is allowed within 20 metres of the refuelling areas or the start finish area.
