Start/Finish:

Will be on private land entered via postcode: **CF32 0BT**. The Open Sprint Format main event will take place over one day.

There will be 8 timed laps for adults and Youth 13-16. Youth 8-12 classes will do 8 timed laps on the shorter course. There will be a sighting lap before the timed laps take place.

Entries and Fees:

Will not be returned unless the event is cancelled or a rider gives a valid reason for not riding, in writing at least 7 days prior to the event. In such cases £10 will be deducted to cover costs. Entries remain open until the 24th June 2022 or when full. If the entry is full then a reserve list will be set up.

Eligibility:

All riders must hold a current ACU or SACU competition licence, and be aged 16 or over. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident insurance.

ACU Membership and ACU Competition Licence:

You will need an annual Enduro Competition Licence, or a one event competition licence, which includes ACU Membership.

Classes + Schedule:

Youth 8 to 12 65cc and 85cc 9:00am start

Championship, Expert, Clubman, Over 40, Ladies, Sportsman, Youth 13 to 16 125cc and 85cc.

Course:

Each lap is approximately 5 miles long and will roughly be 10 minutes to complete for an Expert rider. The Youth 8-12 course is 1 mile long and is easily accessible from the start area..

Refuelling will be at the parking area. The course will consist of Coal Tips, Rocks, Banks, Gulleys, Jumps, Climbs and dirt track.

Markings:

Orange arrows – Main track marking

Taped areas – Main track marking

Crossed arrows will mean extreme caution to be taken. Blue taped areas and pit area is walking pace only. You must travel between gated arrows. Where a single marker is present you must not travel further than 3 metres either side of the marker.

Course cutting will result in **disqualification**. We will be enforcing this and looking out for it with extra presence.

Rules/Penalties:

As laid down in the 2022 ACU Handbook.

Machine Examination/Sign On:

Signing on will be 07:00 – 08:30am.

Noise:

Random noise tests may take place during the event. Failure to stop for a noise test will result in immediate exclusion. Excessively loud motorcycles or motorcycles fitted with aftermarket pipes without DB inserts will be stopped from riding. This venue fragile to noise complaints please help us keep running events in the area.

Tyres:

No Restrictions

Notes:

- Only riders that have signed on can ride or be on the course. Action will be taken against unauthorised persons found riding or driving in the land or on any part of the course.
- Ensure that you do not block the free run of the competitor into and through refuelling points.
- No smoking is allowed within 20 metres of the refuelling areas or the start finish area.
